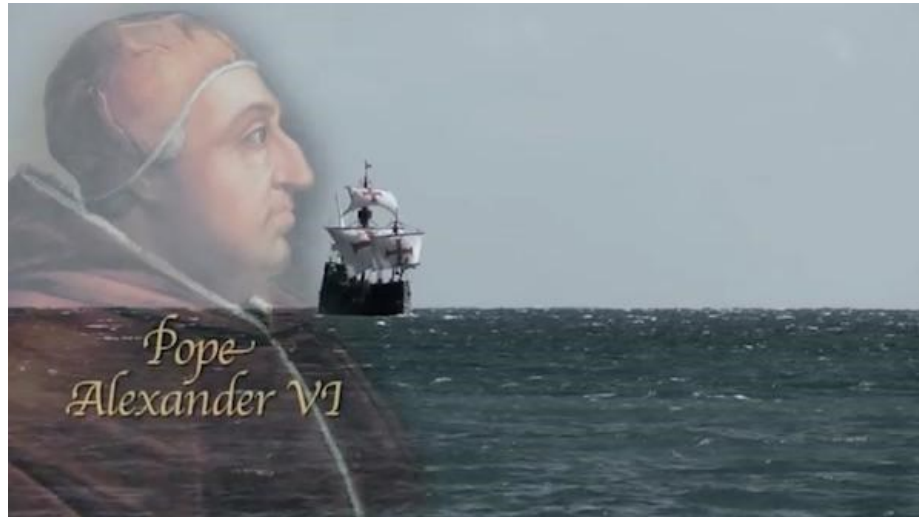


# The Doctrine of Discovery: Unmasking the Domination Code
